Saturday, August 17

Rome to Amalfi Coast/Caserta (B, D)

Depart from Rome early in the morning for the Amalfi Coast . Enjoy a scenic drive along the stunning coastline.

Arrive in Assisi and visit Santa Maria degli Angeli, the Basilica of St. Francis and other important religious sites.

Dinner and overnight in Assisi.

Tuesday, August 20

Assisi - Loreto - Return to Rome (B)

Breakfast at the hotel.

Visit Carlo Acutis' tomb, located in Assisi's Sanctuary of the Renunciation, a part of the Church of St. Mary Major. Depart for Loreto in the late morning.

Visit the Holy House of Loreto. Continue to Lanciano. Depart for Rome in the afternoon.

Arrive back in Rome in the evening.
